Greenfinch Like all finches, the greenfinch has beak that is specially designed to beak seeds. They pick the seed with a beak and then crack it open their beak and then crack it open with their jaw. The tough husk part with their jaw. The tough husk part on the outside of the seed comes off, so the greenfinch can eat the inside of the seed, called the kernel.
