








Christmas Crackers






Resources

You will need:

- Christmas cracker hat nets
- Scissors ▲
- Paper
- Glue stick








Step 1 – Cut out the cracker

- Decorate the cracker
- Carefully cut along all the solid outlines △
- Score and fold the dotted lines A


















Step 2 – Cut out the diamond shapes

- Fold each line that crosses the diamond shapes
- Carefully cut out the diamond shapes △








Step 3 – Fold and Glue Tabs A B C

- Glue tabs A, B and C
- Stick tab A to its opposite edge on the centre of the cracker
- Stick tabs B and C to form the top and bottom



















Step 4 – Tie the cracker

 Tie the bottom of the cracker with ribbon or thin string

















Step 5 – Cut out and make the hat







 Carefully cut out the hat net △ Use sticky tape to join the hat sides together

















Step 6 – Fill the cracker

- Fold the hat and put it in the cracker
- You may wish to put a small gift inside the cracker too
- Tie the top of the cracker and give it to a friend
